POST WORKSHOP EVALUATION ON GREENING COOPERATIVES FOR SUSTAINABLE GROWTH

A total of 14 participants answered the post-workshop evaluation forms. The workshop was evaluated in terms of the content, psycho-social environment and resource persons.

Content of the Workshop

Majority (64.29%) of the participants rated the content in terms of timelines/relevance of the topics as "Best" and half rated the content in terms of knowledge/intellectual challenge, coverage and materials as "Better" (Table 1).

Psycho-Social Environment

Most of the participants (71.43%) rated the psycho-social environment of the workshop in terms of opportunities in discussions as "Best" and majority (64.29%) rated the quality of interaction also as "Best". Half of the participants rated the venue as "Better" while the same percentage (50%) rated the coordinators and staff and time allotment for the workshop as "Best" (Table 2).
